A tax rate of 0.010000 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Medina County Groundwater Conservation District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.010000 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$0.010088 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Medina County Groundwater Conservation District from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Medina County Groundwater Conservation District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Medina County Groundwater Conservation District is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A public hearing on the proposed tax rate will be held on September 16, 2020 at 11:00 AM at 1607 Avenue K, Hondo, TX 78861.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Medina County Groundwater Conservation District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Directors of Medina County Groundwater Conservation District at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.
