

ANNUAL REPORT
Presented to the Board of Directors
January 27, 2016

Consistent with the District's Management Plan, this report outlines management goals and accomplishments for the previous year.

Joint planning with Groundwater Management Areas: Medina County GCD attended six meetings within GMA 9, four meetings within GMA 10, and one meetings within GMA 13. Of GMAs 9, 10, and 13, a method of identifying general progress of meeting the intentions of the adopted DFCs has been agreed upon, and is being pursued. GMAs 9 has adopted a proposed DFC.

District staff gathered water level data on three aquifers on a monthly basis, and twice a year for one and once a year for one additional aquifers, throughout the year. The data was shared within GMA 9, 10, and 13, and was reported to the Board of Directors at the monthly board meeting.

Other Goals:

Providing funding for the MV Soil and Water Conservation District, for educational purposes, in order to aid conservation.

Newspaper advertisements, articles, and public service announcements.

Attended the 2015 Texas Groundwater Summit and a quarterly meeting, composed of various Groundwater Conservation Districts and, State agencies, and partners discussing such matters as the drought, conservation, potential impacts, of Legislative changes and Supreme Court of Texas Rulings.

Attended the Changing Face of Water Rights Seminar, discussing matters of importance to Groundwater Conservation Districts.

Updating of Palmer Drought Severity Index.

Adopted a new Management Plan.
